Do some research and find the answers to each question using the clues below. You will earn the dollar value listed for correct responses. You will have the listed dollar value subtracted from your total for incorrect responses. You may make your own wager for Final Jeopardy; however that wager may not be for more than you actually earned. You will receive 1 extra credit point for every \$1000 you earn in correct responses.

For example, if you earn \$900 in Round 1 and \$1800 in Round 2 you may wager \$2700 in Final Jeopardy; a correct final response would bring your total to \$5400 (and 5.4 extra credit points), whereas an incorrect response would bring your total to \$0 (and 0 extra credit points), SO BET WISELY!
